


# HOW BIG IS MAVERICK?

The all-new Ford Maverick may be more compact in size than other Built Ford Tough trucks, but is capable of carrying 1,500 pounds (equivalent to around 37 bags of 40-pound mulch) or towing a 23-foot camper trailer weighing up to 4,000 pounds\*. As a full standard hybrid it's the most fuel efficient pickup truck on the market\*\*, targeting an EPA-estimated 40 mpg city fuel economy\* and 500 miles of range\*\*.
